



# Computation and Informatics in Biology and Medicine (CIBM) Training Program

## Short-term Traineeships

### I. General Information

The CIBM short-term traineeships are open to trainees who will work with CIBM Trainers as mentors (see attached list). Short-term traineeships are available to undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate trainees. The short-term traineeships must take place at UW-Madison. The training period must last for a minimum of two months and a maximum of three months. In addition, the short-term trainees must be U.S. citizens or hold Permanent Resident status.

- Include your transcripts(s); GRE scores (if applicable), and proof of citizenship (a copy of your birth certificate, passport, driver's license, or social security card)
- Include 10 copies of the entire application
